 - a. Intersection of Adams at Cottage - Request for stop signs as right of way is unclear

- b. Areas of Phillip St and 100 block of Elm. Concerns over vehicles operating too fast for the narrow roadway. Request for additional warning/ safety signs for pedestrian and cyclist traffic.

- c. Pleasant St.- multiple concerns over speed on a roadway without ample room and many walkers for school. Request for speed alert sign and/or reduction of speed limit.

- d. Request from Selectman Peterson via concerns to his office:
 - 1) Vehicles not stopping 109 at North St
 - 2) Traffic blocking 109 at Brook St.
 - 3) Request for bike/foot officer during early release days in the center of Town
 - 4) Request for MBTA assessment

- e. Causeway speed concerns

- f. Philip @ Elm St. – Concern over narrow roadway, pedestrian use and speed. Traffic enforcement was performed with few violations. Request for signage to assist in slowing traffic down.
