

SOLID WASTE STUDY COMMITTEE

Date: June 16, 1999

Time: 7:30 PM

Present: Ann Thompson, Ken Feeney, Barry Colt, Cynthia Greene, and Kristine Trierweiler

1. Waste Management (WM) is continuing under the Maraggio contract

- Town House trash is still picked up for no fee
- School contract has been honored however, it runs out at the end of next year)
- John Horvak of WM will be at the meeting on 6/23 at 8:15 PM

2. Committee discussed the need to have a contract with WM at the end of the year.

3. Waste Management would like to take residential customer trash directly to Wheelebrator and dump under our contract. Would not use the Transfer Station, which would represent approximately 25 ton/week.

- It currently costs approximately \$104 for the DPW to haul the trash to Wheelebrator
- WM—25/ton a week in residential 15/ton a week in commercial
- WM would also take approx. 8/ton a week of co-mingled recyclables out of Town
- Would need to weigh in at Sam White's and again at Wheelebrator to ensure that only Medfield trash is being dumped under our contract.

4. The Committee will make a separate recommendation to the Selectmen regarding this situation. The Committee voted not to recommend renegotiation of the Wheelebrator contract at this time.

5. Definitions:

Residential (I)(A)

Simple fee structure

Sticker Fee?

Question still arises that we are taxing only a certain portion of the population

Stickers should be serialized and accounted for

Residential (II)(S)

Personal construction projects

(1) Pick-up Load limit

Residential (III)(B)

Leased cars must be registered in Medfield

Allowing stickers on cards will alleviate problem of company cars

Exceptions of registering your car in Medfield will be on an individual basis to be handled by the Board of Selectmen

Commercial (I)(R)

Haulers must require recycling by customers

Must be able to prove that trash/recyclables are from Medfield

Must file a list of customers and collection route with DPW/TS

Penalty for non-compliance

Commercial (II)(N)

Not eligible to deposit trash into the Medfield Transfer Station

6. Other Points

Fine Schedule needs to be determined

Better signage is needed for TS, dedicated breakdown/TS lane

Better signage is needed for recyclable boxes in TS

Education is most important---Issue a booklet outlining all rules/regulations

Advertising on Web Site, Cable Access, Suburban Press, Hometown Weekly
