

SOLID WASTE STUDY COMMITTEE

Date: June 30, 1999

1. Mr. Colt presented a letter for the Selectmen regarding the Solid Waste Committee's position on WM's proposal to use our tip fee at Wheelebrator
 - Letter states that the Committee's position to support this proposal
 - Mr. Feeney agrees with the Committee's position as long as WM weighs in before they leave Medfield and when they arrive at Wheelebrator
2. Mr. Harney does not go along with this recommendation and encouraged the Committee to discuss this further. Mr. Harney does not believe the town should subsidize a private business.
3. Committee discussed this issue at great length and voted 5-1 with John Harney in the negative to send the support of the WM proposal to the Selectmen with one change. The tip fee will be shared with WM for 6 months while we review the situation further. After six months the situation will be revisited and a final determination made.
4. Committee discussed the need to review the cost of scales for the TS
5. Ms. Thompson suggested that we put members of the Committee at TS to explain the educational brochure once it is issued.
6. The Committee should be reviewing final report: order of parts, indices, and appendices. Mr. Colt asked the Committee for any changes to be presented at the next meeting.
7. Mr. Harding presented his MEMO piece for the final report. Mr. Harney asked that the words "blunt and abrasive" be removed from the report. The Committee agreed to leave the report as written.
8. Next meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, July 7, 1999 at 7:30.
