

SOLID WASTE STUDY COMMITTEE

1. Ms. Thompson made a motion to approve the minutes of May 18, 1999, seconded by Mr. Harding and the vote was unanimous.
2. Ms. Greene made a motion to approve the minutes of June 2, 1999, seconded by Ms. Thompson and the vote was unanimous.
3. The SWSC will present its preliminary findings to the Board of Selectmen on July 13, 1999.
4. Ms. Trierweiler condensed the results of the Town wide survey so that the statistical information can be included in the preliminary report. Committee reviewed and revised for the report.

7. Mr. Colt, Ms. Trierweiler, and Mr. Feeney will present findings to the Selectmen on July 13, 1999
8. Mr. Colt and Ms. Trierweiler will continue work on the Preliminary Report of the SWSC.
9. Ms. Thompson made a motion that the SWSC remain in effect throughout the changes to the Transfer Station, seconded by Mr. Harding and the vote was unanimous
