Electronics – Collection of TVs (CRT, LCD and Plasma), monitors, computers, laptops, printers/scanners/faxes, printer cartridges, radios, stereos, entertainment systems, all cables and wires, projectors, all telephones, CDs, floppy discs, servers, Printed Circuit Boards, rechargeable batteries, all consumer electronics. The Swap Area – Collection of household items - provides residents an opportunity to find a new life for their items. It is open Wed, Fri and Sat. from May through October 9-3 (drop off only until 2:30). The Swap accepts clean, working (or easily repairable) household items that can be used by someone else. Categories of acceptable items are: Toys/Games/Educational materials; Bicycles/Exercise Equipment/Sporting Goods; Household items; Household Electric Items; Decorative Items; Baby Items; Tools/Hardware; Building Materials(limited quantity); Garden/Yard Items; Office Furniture/Supplies; Furniture; Entertainment Items; Books and Magazines. The Swap area does NOT accept any materials that are not accepted as solid waste at the Transfer Station (e.g., TVs, CRTs, automobile parts, tires, oil, concrete, and gypsum). Town.medfield.net

Furniture/Household items for resale to benefit the Aids Action Committee – Collection of living room, bedroom and dining room furniture in good condition. Also collecting artwork, picture frames, vases, collectibles, giftware, kitchenware and linens. They do not accept mattresses, futons, sleep sofas, used bedding, TVs, computers, large appliances, small appliances with filters and large exercise equipment. Please clean pet hair off items prior to donation due to allergies. Shopboomerangs.org

Reusable Building Materials for resale – high quality – no construction or demolition debris – Collecting cabinets, countertops, sinks, appliances (less than 5 yrs old), vanities, ceramic tile, vinyl and wood replacement windows, doors and hardware (interior, exterior, storm – no lead paint), lumber, drywall, plywood (6 ft. minimum length, no scraps, half sheets or larger of plywood and drywall), exterior shutters, carpeting, sheet vinyl, wood flooring, paint (full containers, minimum 2 gallons for interior and 5 gallons for exterior of the same color, neutrals and pastels only). No glass of any kind. If you would not share it with a friend, please don't bring it. NewLife Home Refurnishing is a Medfield, MA not-for-profit organization with a warehouse at 102 Elm Street in Walpole, MA serving the surrounding communities. As a furniture bank, we accept tax-deductible donations of gently used furniture and household items that are then made available to individuals and families in need. We are members of the National Furniture Bank Association of North America (www.fbana.org) Clients come to us through referrals from social service and government agencies, as well as area clergy. We serve individuals and families overcoming difficult circumstances such as fires or floods, homelessness, veterans of war and recent refugees. Our goal is to treat our clients with dignity and provide them basic necessities from our inventory to give them a new start. One of the greatest needs is for mattresses, box springs and clean bedding. www.newlifehr.org.

Styrofoam - Foam items do **not** have to display the recycling symbol 6 in the triangle with PS underneath it! We will accept packing blocks, produce and meat trays, take out containers (please rinse), hot cups such as Dunkin' Donuts, Honey Dew and Cumberland Farms (without paper or cardboard infused), foam egg cartons, trays, white insulation sheets ,#4 (PE) Polyethylene foam, #5 (PP) Polypro foam, bubble wrap, and packing peanuts (bagged separately from your foam). Will NOT accept: Plastic utensils, foam cups infused with cardboard or paper such as McDonalds, Newman, and Burger King (ice tea cup), biodegradable produce and meat-trays for example, GenPak without the recycling symbol, cardboard egg cartons, soft foam pads, food containers with plastic film attached(some ground turkey comes in these containers), blue or pink insulation sheets.

AFTER MAY 31, NEXT STYROFOAM COLLECTION IS OCTOBER 31, 2015.

Medications/Drugs – Medfield Police Station offers free disposal of drugs you no longer need. Drugs from landfills and flushed down household toilets are being detected in groundwater. Collected drugs will be safely destroyed. Accepted drugs include: prescription medication, pills, capsules, patches, prescription ointments, prescription liquids in unbreakable, leak-proof containers and vitamins – No sharps www.norfolkda.com.
