

MSH Community Workshop Small Group Discussion Guidance

Each small group should review the presentation and the 2 scenarios for the future of the Medfield State Hospital area. Each small group is asked to discuss the features of the future scenarios and assess it as to the objectives established by the Select Board and the MSHMPC that appeared in the 2015 Town Report. The alternative reuse scenarios try to balance competing uses, needs and priorities incorporating the feedback provided in earlier surveys and at the February 2017 Open House.

We want your comments on the balance and how well these scenarios advance Medfield's objectives. Please let us know how well you feel that each scenario addresses the objectives and how the scenario could perhaps better advance specific objectives using the matrix. The responses should be the opinion of your small group not individual comments. Have a discussion; exchange views; and develop and shared perspective amongst your table-mates. Please use the matrix to guide your discussion and responses.

We recognize that there are many elements and goals. You can feel free to focus on the main MSH campus, or a smaller geographic area, depending upon your group's interest and time constraints.

Each small group should select a person to be a spokesperson (the reporter) and a notetaker (the recorder). Ideally, this should be a person who is not involved on the MSHMPC or the MSH Resource Committee. We want this workshop to be an opportunity for more voices to be heard. Thank you.
