Please consider this letter to be a request for a further continuance to the Planning Board's October meeting of the presently scheduled hearing of August 20, 2018 which was a continuance of the hearing on Medfield Holdings, LLC's Request for Modification of the previously issued Site Plan Approval for 80-82 Pleasant Street.

The context for this request is briefly as follows:


Since the time of the last hearing, Mr. Borelli has met with the current owners of 80-82 Pleasant Street. Mr. Borrelli, with the assent of the present owners, has agreed at his cost to install the fence on the northerly side of the property (closest to 76 Pleasant Street) that had by inadvertence previously not be installed. Once installed, Mr. Borelli intends to request that the Planning Board permit him to withdraw his request for Site Plan Modification.

In addition, Mr. Borrelli, again with the consent of the present owners, has agreed at his cost to plant two Maple trees in the backyard and to plant Arbor Vitae to screen the present Unit B patio on the side of the house closest to 84 Pleasant Street. These plantings will be complete by the end of September. Because of concerns about the effect of heat, it is not recommended that plantings take place in August.

It is expected by the time of the Planning Board's October meeting any issues previously raised during the July meeting will have been addressed and satisfactorily resolved, and all parties will have the benefit of seeing the completion of the above described additional work.

Thank you for your consideration of this request. I understand that in lieu of my appearance on August 20, 2018 you have agreed to accept this letter. To the extent there are any applicable deadlines for any Board action, the applicant hereby waives any such deadlines.
