FY20 Budget Overview

- July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2020
- CARES funding utilized on eligible COVID related expenses
- Local receipts down from prior years
- Town Accountant closing books and working on Free Cash certification (late October)



FY20 Local Receipts

- Projection: \$4,372,096
- Actual: \$4,376,832
- 6.6% reduction from FY2019
- Lowest total since FY2014



FY21 Budget Status

- Using CARES funding for eligible, COVID related expenses
 - Expenses must be incurred between 3/1/2020 and 12/30/2020
 - Only eligible if expenses were *unbudgeted* as of 3/27/2020
- Still no approved state budget



FY21 State Aid

- FY21 Budget projection reduced state aid projection by 10% due to lack of guidance from the state
- July 30 Announcement: Legislature and Governor commit to level funding from FY20
- Awaiting guidance from DLS regarding how to apply updated figures

FY21 State Aid

- FY21 Projected State Aid: \$7,262,845
- FY21 State Aid agreement: \$7,952,648
 - Increase of \$689,803
 - Unrestricted general aid increase: \$115,138
 - Chapter 70 increase: \$561,023
- FY21 Assessments still not final
 - FY21 Projected Assessments: \$843,199
 - FY21 Updated Assessments, per DLS: \$842,313



FY21 Budget Status

- Health Insurance
 - Anticipate increase of \$192,000 over FY20
 - Increase occurring despite *reduction* in premiums (more employees on insurance)
- Unemployment
- Open Contracts with Police and Fire

FY22 Outlook

- State Budget and financial guidance
 - Still no approved FY21 state budget
 - Senate President Spilka: FY21 Budget unlikely until after the election
 - Speaker DeLeo: “very concerned” over lack of federal funding
 - Ways and Means Revenue Roundtable on October 7
 - FY21 shortfall: \$4-6 billion gap
 - State rainy day fund: \$3.5 billion
 - FY22 state budget process supposed to start in January

FY22 Outlook

- Federal stimulus still uncertain
- Economic growth

FY22 Outlook

- Fixed costs
 - Health insurance
 - Other insurance
 - 111F
 - General and property liability
 - Workers compensation
- Contribution to retirement system
- Medfield State Hospital operations/maintenance
- Collective Bargaining Agreements
 - Police
 - Fire



FY22 Outlook

- Significant reductions to balance FY21 Budget
 - Transfer to Stabilization
 - Level funded OPEB
 - Reductions in workforce
 - Elimination of COLA/Merit
- Use of One-time funds
 - Free Cash
 - Health insurance credit



FY22 Outlook

- Capital Budget
 - Funded minimal capital in FY21
 - FY22 lease payments: \$101,000
