Parking: Parking is available at Medfield High School and Middle School.

Handicapped Accessible parking is available at the main entrance to the High School

Entrance: Please enter through the Main Entrance to Medfield High School

Check In: Voter check-in with the Town Clerk will be located in the main Lobby. All registered voters must check in to be given a bracelet for voting.

Registration will close upon the call of the vote by the Town Moderator. No exceptions will be made after registration has been closed. You will **NOT** be allowed to vote if you do not have a bracelet.

Indoor/Outdoor Option: The main indoor space will be the Gymnasium. Once the gymnasium reaches capacity, "satellite" rooms will be opened and attendees will be directed accordingly. Attendees may remain outside if they prefer and a tent will be available adjacent to the high school.

Please Note: Attendees who would like to stay outside must still first enter the high school to check in with the Town Clerk, receive a bracelet to be eligible to vote, and then return outside.

Voting: Voting will take place at each location, when the vote is called you will be directed by row to the voting areas in your location, we ask that you respect social distancing and be patient.

Masks: Masks will be **required** at all times.

High School Library The Library has been reserved for those that may be at especially high risk for COVID-19 due to age or comorbidities. This space will be limited in capacity to ensure social distancing.

Satellite Rooms: Live video and microphones will be available in all overflow rooms including the outside tent area.

Restrooms: Restrooms are located inside the High School.

Sanitizer: Hand sanitizer stations will be available at check-in and each satellite room.

Should I Attend? The Massachusetts Department of Public Health and the Medfield Board of Health has advised that residents not attend in person if you are exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms, such as fever, sore throat, shortness of breath, chills, muscle pain, loss of taste or smell, or if you have been potentially exposed to COVID-19.
