## Town Administrator's Office

- The Town Administrator, members of the Select Board and local delegation welcomed the Secretary of the Executive Office of Housing and Livable Communities, Ed Augustus to the Medfield State Hospital on a walking tour led by our development partners Trinity Financial
- Medfield was one of 27 communities in Massachusetts to be awarded the Green Communities Grant. Medfield will receive \$200,000 to go towards heat pumps at the library, insulation at the Town House and variable frequency drives at the High School
