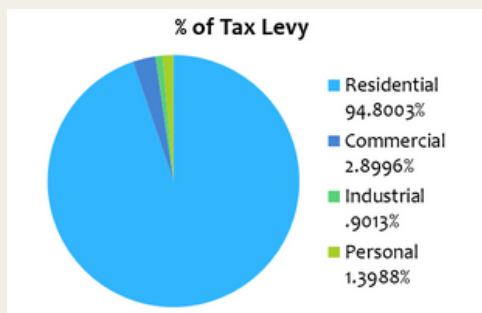


Town Administrator's Office
