


Town Administrator's Office

- A big thank you to the the Town Clerk for designing and Department of Public Works for their assistance in installing the new drop box on Janes Ave just in time for the 2024 elections!
- The Department of Public Works also assisted the Parks and Recreation Department with the removal of the old playground equipment at Hinkley Playground in anticipation of new equipment going in sometime in early summer

Facilities

- The Town completed installation work in the Town House attic which is projected to reduce natural gas consumption by 27% annually and electricity use by a smaller fraction, .2%. Insulating the attic will reduce carbon emissions by 5.4 tons each year.

Fire Department

- Captain/EMTP Eric Littmann who has been with the fire department for five years and was part of the initial ALS hiring, has moved on to become the Director of the Massachusetts Fire Academy.
- FF/EMTP Nicholas Andexler has been promoted to Captain and is assigned to Group 1. The department has hired Dover resident Nick Novitch as our newest fulltime firefighter. Nick is currently in paramedic school and finishing his firefighter certification. Nick will start March 20 and is assigned to Group 2
- The Medfield Fire Department was awarded \$19,000 as part of the FY24 Firefighter Equipment Grant to purchase ballistic vests and helmets for firefighters

Trinity Financial Update

- Trinity Financial has submitted a Part II Amendment to the National Park Service and Massachusetts Historical Commission, addressing requests for further details including information on windows, doors, and flooring. The project team is reviewing a proposed contract for infrastructure design, which will be funded through grants secured by the Town and is preparing documentation for the upcoming infrastructure funding round.
