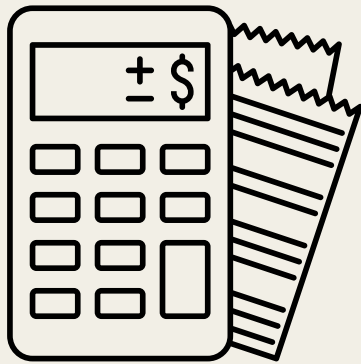


Facilities
