- On 03/28 and 04/01, the Planning Board and Select Board held joint hearings on the proposed MBTA Zoning language for Town Meeting, which would allow for multi-family use by-right in some areas of town, as required by the newly amended MGL Ch 40A § 3A. While the hearings are now closed, the Director of Land Use will be hosting "Coffee with a Planner" sessions soon, for any interested residents looking to learn more.
