To the Constables of the Town of Medfield in Said County, Greetings:

In the Name of the Commonwealth, you are directed to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Medfield, qualified to vote in elections and in town affairs, to meet at the Center at Medfield on Ice House Road in said Medfield on **MONDAY, THE THIRTY-FIRST** day of March, A.D. 2025 at 6:00 o'clock A.M., then and there to act on the following purpose:

To choose all Town Officers required to be elected annually by ballot, viz:

One Moderator for One Year

One Select Board Member, One Assessor, Two School Committee Members, Two Library Trustees, and Three Park Commissioners for Three years.

One Member of the Planning Board for Five Years

One Member of the Housing Authority for Five Years

Question:

Shall this town approve the charter amendment proposed by the town meeting to amend Article 2 Legislative Branch: Open Town Meeting Section 2-4 Moderator and Deputy Moderator; election, appointive powers, terms, compensation, as summarized below?

Summary:

This charter amendment amends the first sentence of Section 2-4 to change the term of the Moderator from one year to three years, beginning with the 2026 annual election.
