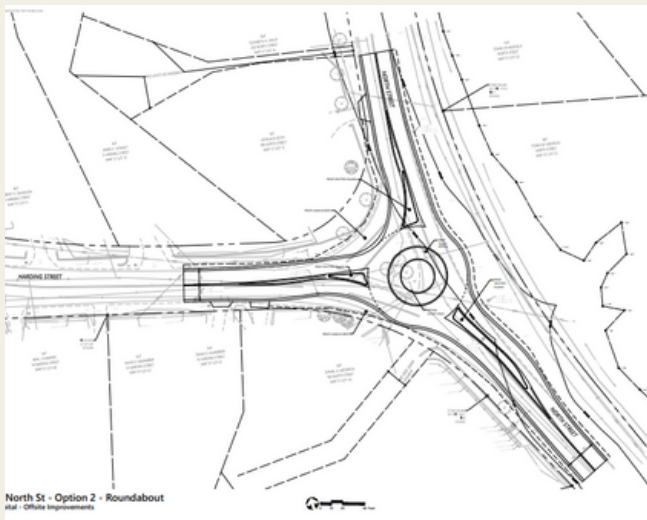

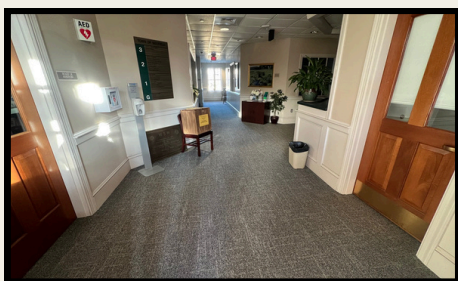

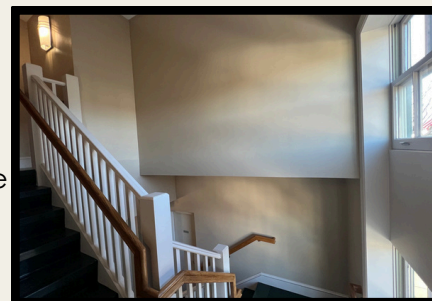


Local Boy Scout Troop holds mock Town Meeting

## Trinity Financial Update

- Trinity Financial continues to make progress on the Medfield State Hospital redevelopment. This month, the Medfield Historic District Commission approved plans for 28 buildings. The development team is now working with VHB to advance the design of three off-site intersections approved by the Medfield Select Board.
- We continue collaborating with the Cultural Alliance of Medfield and the Town to secure state funding for critical infrastructure improvements and hazardous materials remediation within the buildings. The team is also preparing its Subdivision and Stormwater approval applications for submission to the Planning Board while working to satisfy the conditions of the conditional site plan approval.



# Council on Aging

- The Center is gearing up for AARP Tax Prep Appointments. This free service is provided by AARP trained tax-preparers and is intended for people with simple returns with low and moderate income. Last year we helped prepare 103 returns, up from 28 from the previous year. We estimate this free service to save resident \$15,000-\$20,000. (\$150-\$200 for a simple return) All appointments for this year have been claimed, but we do have a wait list available. To get on the waitlist, please call Lois at 508-359-3665.
