Medfield School Building Committee



- At the April meeting the SBC continued to complete the administrative requirements in Module One of the MSBA process. As of April 1st, the SBC may now begin submitting the various documents to complete Module One. At the April meeting the SBC focused on reviewing the first draft of the *Educational Profile Questionnaire*. This document explains the district's current and proposed educational facilities, teaching methodology, grade configurations and program offerings.
- One of the requirements in Module One is the town must successfully approve the money for a Feasibility Study. At previous Town Meetings, the SBC received funds for a future Feasibility Study. We currently have 1.1 million. After discussing what Feasibility Studies are currently costing neighboring towns, the SBC decided that 1.5 million will be needed. At our annual May Town meeting there will be a Warrant Article requesting additional funds for this important next step in a future building project. We hope to see you at the Annual Town Meeting!

- The Council on Aging hosted an appreciation dinner for all the incredible volunteers who dedicate time to the CENTER.



Trinity Financial Update



- Trinity Financial, in partnership with the Town and the Bellforge Arts Center, is advancing the redevelopment of the Medfield State Hospital campus. At the end of March, Trinity submitted its final site plan approval and subdivision approval applications to the Planning Board and its stormwater application to the Board of Health. The team is also preparing applications to the HousingWorks Infrastructure Program and the Underutilized Properties Program through the state's One Stop for Growth. Funding awards would support public infrastructure construction for the campus. Last year, MassWorks awarded \$500,000 to the project.
